* Northern populations of the Black-thighed Puffleg (*Eriocnemis derbyi*) have a slightly longer bill and are sometimes regarded as a separate subspecies *longirostris*, although variation is clinal.

* In northern Colombia, populations of the Golden-breasted Puffleg (*Eriocnemis mosquera*) are sometimes seen as a separate subspecies *bogotensis*, although variation is clinal.
