\* The Australasian Figbird (*Sphecotheres vieilloti*) is sometimes considered conspecific with the Timor Figbird (*Sphecotheres viridis*) and the Wetar Figbird (*Sphecotheres hypoleucus*). In addition, the subspecies *flaviventris* is sometimes seen as a separate species.
